

Theme: Stepping out with Jesus - Taking a risk by moving those feet!!

Instructions for Activity (Next Page)

This is a fun group activity. Get people into groups of 4-8 with mixture of ages. They all get question one to start. They find out the answer and then send a 'runner' up to the markers (2-3). They check it and then give the group the next one. (Alternatively each group can be given the whole pack to start...) but can only go onto the next when the previous one has been marked correct!

Each question to answer may take 2-3 mins... put a cut off time limit on it... adjust number of questions as you need to

Write the number of the group on each sheet for easy identification

Cut out questions above, stack in order with this one on the bottom from 1-10... staple to keep in order.

Work out the rules i.e. good for young kids to bring up answers or all to take a turn bringing/writing
